### Transfer in Denmark

Transportation to and from Billund Airport is paid and organized by you.

### Outbound flight

Departure: Billund Airport, Passagerterminalen 10, 7190 Billund

Meeting point and time: We will meet at 17.00 inside the departure terminal.

Transfer: By private coach to Wombat City Hostel.

### Hostel

We will be staying at Wombat City Hostel. What used to be sailors' lodgings back in the 1800s is now a modern hostel. With great attention to detail, Wombat's celebrates the legacy of the historic building. Old oak that was previously part of sturdy ships and churches is now immortalized in the furniture throughout the house.

Wombat City Hostel is situated in the London Borough of Tower Hamlets, right next to famous Tower Bridge and Tower of London, charming markets, authentic pubs, and plenty of other historic sights. A short walk will see you in the trendy Borough of Shoreditch with vibrant street art, pulsing life and some of the best curries outside of India. All other hotspots in London are easily accessible by public transport from Aldgate East and Tower Hill.

In the morning a Tasty Brekkie buffet ensures you have enough energy for your exciting day, and in the evening Wombat's awaits you with free WiFi, a cozy courtyard, spacious lobby and womBAR. Here you can unwind and enjoy yourself.

You will be staying in rooms of 4-8 beds with ensuite bathrooms and private lockers. You need to bring your own towel but bedding is provided.

### Transportation in London

We recommend that you just use your contactless credit cards (Visa, Mastercard and the like). Like Visitor Oyster Cards and Oyster Cards, contactless credit cards can be used at all entrances/exits, you pay as you go and the price is the same as for the other cards. However, it is possible to order visitor oyster cards and travelcards prior to travelling. You can also buy oyster cards and tickets at the Underground stations.

## Checklist

Remember to bring the following.

- Passport with ETA
- Medical card (sygesikringskort) – both yellow and blue
- Student card
- Money/visa card for meals every day and transportation
- Clothes and food wear suited for weather and occasion
- Dress code for Formal: Formal clothing
- Toiletries
- Towel
- Pen and paper

The hostel provides linen for the beds.

## Baggage

You are allowed to bring:

- 1 bag (checked baggage) max. 23 kg. and dimension 90 x 75 x 43cm
- 1 cabin bag max. 23 kg. and dimensions 56 x 45 x 25cm
- 1 handbag/laptop bag max. 23 kg. and dimensions 40 x 30 x 15cm

You are allowed to bring one 1-litre reclosable bag for liquids in your handbag. In this bag, you can bring as many containers (100ml) as fits in it. Otherwise, you can bring liquids in your checked baggage.
