Meeting point and time: We will meet at 9.00 in Terminal 3 under the departure board. Flight times: British Airways (BA805) departs at 10.50 and arrives at 12.10 (local times).

Arrival: Heathrow Airport, Nelson Road, Hounslow, Middlesex, TW6 2GW

Transfer: By Underground to Astor Hyde Park.

Hostel

We will be staying at Astor Hyde Park. Located in the beautiful and charming South Kensington in London, Astor Hyde Park is one minute from Hyde Park and surrounded by some of London's greatest museums including the Natural History Museum, Victoria & Albert and Science Museum.

The reception is open 24 hours/day, and the hostel offers free wi-fi. It has big and good common areas, and it is possible to cook for yourselves in a shared kitchen. A continental breakfast buffet is served.

You will be staying in rooms of 4-8 beds with private bath and toilet. In the rooms you will find lockers. You need to bring your own towel but linen is provided.

Flight times: British Airways (BA818) departs at 14.05 and arrives at 17.00 (local times).

Arrival: Kastrup Airport, Lufthavnsboulevarden 6, 2770 Kastrup

Transfer in Denmark

Transportation to Billund Airport and from Kastrup Airport is paid and organized by you.

Transportation in London

It is possible to order visitor oyster cards and travelcards prior to travelling. You can also buy oyster cards and tickets at the Underground stations. However, unless you already have an Oyster Card, which you can just top up at the Underground stations, we recommend that you just use your contactless credit cards (Visa, Mastercard m.fl.). Like Visitor Oyster Cards and Oyster Cards, contactless credit cards can be used at all entrances/exits, you pay as you go and the price is the same as for the other cards.

Checklist

Remember to bring the following.

- Passport
- Medical card (sygesikringskort) both yellow and blue
- Student card
- Money/visa card for meals every day and transportation
- Clothes and food wear suited for weather and occasion
- Dress code for Formal: Formal clothing
- Toiletries
- Towel
- Pen and paper

The hostel provides linen for the beds.

Baggage

You are allowed to bring:

- 1 bag (checked baggage) max. 23 kg. and dimension 90 x 75 x 43cm
- 1 handbag max. 23 kg. and dimensions 56 x 45 x 25cm
- 1 additional handbag/laptop bag max. 23 kg. and dimensions 40 x 30 x 15cm

You are allowed to bring one 1-litre reclosable bag for liquids in your handbag. In this bag, you can bring as many containers (100ml) as fits in it. Otherwise, you can bring liquids in your checked baggage.


